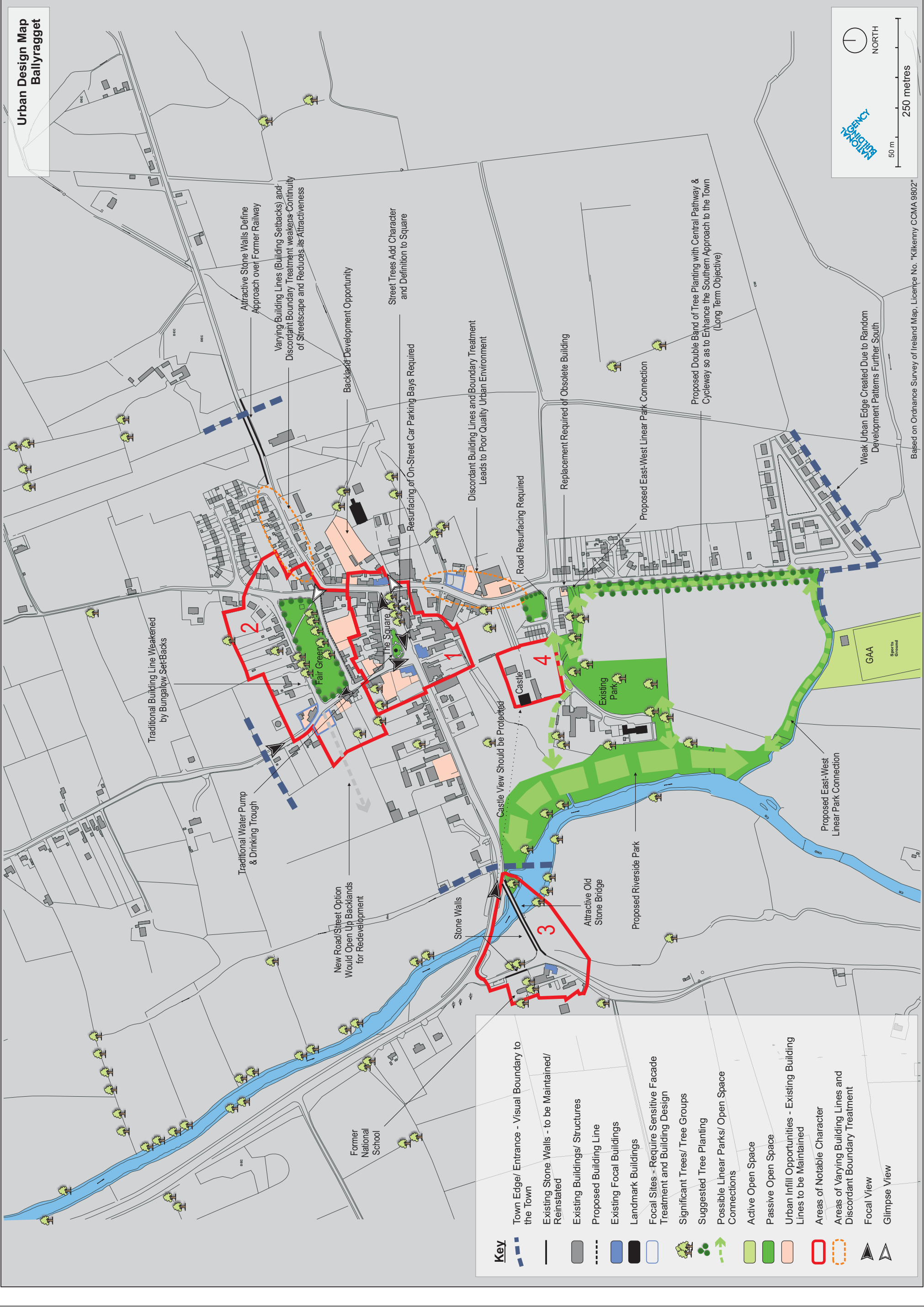


Urban Design Map Ballyragget
